

# ALESSANDRO SCHIATTARELLA

Alessandro Schiattarella was born in Naples in 1982. He finished his dance studies at Rudra Bejart in Lausanne.

In 2016 he graduated in Dance Science at the University of Bern. In 2020 has completed a Master's degree in Fine Arts at FHNW Basel. As a performer he collaborated with Maurice Bejart, Marco Goecke, Koen Augustijnen, Haris Pasovic and Theatre de Geneve, Konzert Theater Bern, Scapino Ballett Rotterdam, Theater Basel, among others.

In 2014 he created his first solo "Altrove" which was then selected in the prestigious international platform Aerowaves Twenty17. Since 1996 he is affected from a rare disease called "Hirayama Disease", which has led him since 2015 to develop choreographic projects in the field of disability which have been presented at ROXY Birsfelden, Dampfzentrale Bern, Aerowaves Twenty17 and many other international and local festivals and theatres. Since 2016 he has been supported by Pro Helvetia's Swiss Arts Council for cultural exchanges: seminars, workshops and projects between Switzerland and other countries.
