Womb Dance complete project integration documentary film was selected for the Durban International Film Festival, Rwanda Film Festival Competition and screened at the INTERDOC masterclass in Serbia. Womb Dance is to have Latin American subtitles.

Rratsheko was selected to participate at the Multichoice Talent Incubator.

Rratsheko worked across South African Developing Countries (SADC) as selected scene director, translator and radio editor on Birdingwaters mini-series. He worked as DoP in Benin and Ghana in more than 10 rural communities during the filming of Land grabs mini-series.
